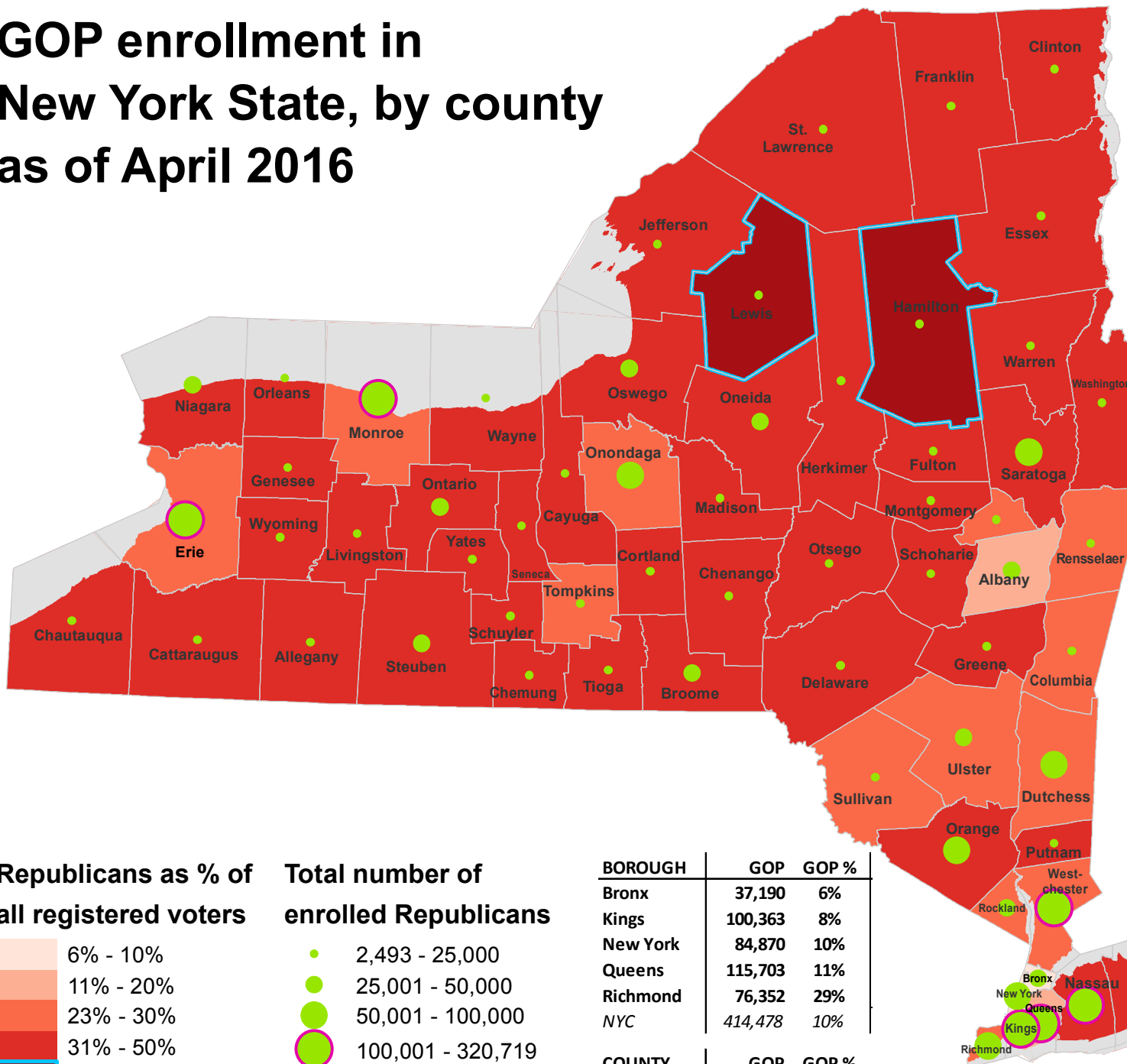
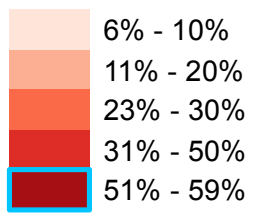


GOP enrollment in New York State, by county as of April 2016

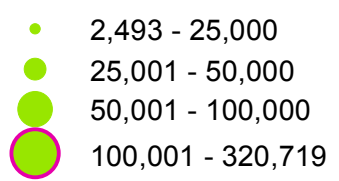
